1) The three zoologists had different tasks: De Filippi was to collect vertebrates and geological data, while Lessona and Doria gathered arthropods and molluscs. The Mission reached Tehran through the Caucasus Mountains only in early August and began its journey back home at the end of the same month, after climbing Mount Damavand, the highest peak in the Elburz Mountains; however, Doria chose to continue his journey.

2) As President of the Società Geografica Italiana, he promoted and supported various exploration trips to remote lands. These trips were aimed to expand the geographical knowledge of unexplored regions but were often made for military purposes and colonial expansion. The travellers were trained in Genoa by Gestro to properly collect and preserve their finds, which were sent either to Genoa if zoological or to Florence if botanical or ethnoanthropological (then to Rome).

3) The first batch of South American specimens arrived at the Museum was sent by Giorgio Sivori, a Genoese who for many years lived in Montevideo, Uruguay, and collected a wealth of entomological and ornithological specimens around the city. Back to his homeland and named honorary consul of Uruguay in Genoa, in 1869 he donated his collections thanks to the mediation of his young grandson, Giorgio Caneva, a frequenter and collaborator of the Museum.

4) Interested in biological pest control, Silvestri carried out many long trips to various regions of the world to study insects harmful to plants and their natural parasites. The author of 470 publications written in different languages, he was a renowned specialist of myriapods and various groups of insects, among which he described two new orders: the Protura in 1907 and the Zoraptera in 1913.

5) The Chiropterology section (over 2,000 vials just for specimens in alcohol) has particular significance thanks to the great work of Giacomo Doria (1840-1913), who was drawn to the study of bats in the last few years of his life, gathered some himself and, more importantly, had many collected in Italy and all over the world from an increasingly vast network of correspondents and thanks to exchanges with different museums and institutes.
